

Nelson Minor Hockey Association Game Day Facility Safety Plans (NDCC and CIVIC Arenas)

Updated November 6

- 1. **Essential Participant list** Each team must email their contact list by 5pm, the day before game day, to the Nelson team contact. Include the name and phone number of <u>all team participants</u> that will be present for each game. NMHA Team contact information is listed below.
- 2. **Covid Screening** All teams are responsible to do their own Covid screening on game day. See this link for information on what to do if anybody reports feeling unwell: <u>https://www.bchockey.net/ImageManagement/ReadBigRealImage.aspx?id=9292</u>
- 3. Follow **Facility Safety plans** for the NDCC and CIVIC arenas (available on the NMHA website). This includes an outline of entering and exiting the facilities.
- 4. Only * ESSENTIAL TEAM PARTICIPANTS are permitted into the facility. NMHA will provide an attendant to greet all players and team participants at the entrance door of the arena (exit and entrance doors are outlined in the facility safety plan) <u>Maximum 65 participants allowed in the arena</u>. Facility staff are not included in this total.
- 5. Entering and exiting the facility Teams cannot enter the facility until 15 minutes prior to their ice time and must exit within 15 minutes after their ice time. The teams must enter all at once with all team participants. All participants must use the hand sanitizer provided upon entry to the arena.
- 6. **Dressing rooms** Players can get dressed in the dressing room. Check the dressing room assignment at the bottom of the stairs when entering the dressing room hallway in the NDCC and on the outside of the entrance door for the CIVIC.

- 7. Female dressing rooms are available in both arenas.
- 8. **Showers** are not permitted.
- 9. **Masks** are mandatory for players at all times, until they put on their helmet prior to going on the ice, and after removing their helmet when returning to the dressing room. All Essential team Officials and team participants must wear masks at all times.
- 10. Safety Rules No spitting anywhere inside the facility. No sharing of water bottles.
- 11. Warm up There will be no warm up allowed inside the facilities

12. No spectators are allowed at this time.

*<u>ESSENTIAL TEAM PARTICIPANTS</u> include for each team:

- 17 skaters
- 2 goal tenders
- 3 coaches
- 1 manager
- 1 safety person
- 1 Covid ambassador **
- 1 team helper (optional)
- 1 team videographer (optional)

****Covid Ambassador** – a Covid Ambassador is MANDATORY. The Covid ambassador must ensure their team is following the Covid protocols as laid out in this document.
